📖 English – We looked closely at the features of newspaper reports and even interviewed eyewitnesses linked to the mysterious events in the book Tuesday.

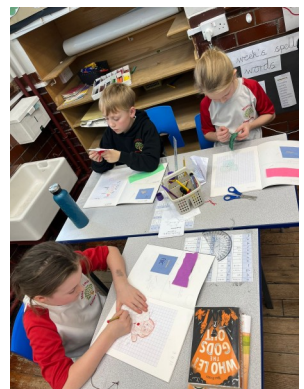
🧵 DT – Children carried on creating their beautiful cross-stitch Christmas cards.

- 12th December **clean/unused/new toys, games, or any prizes that can be used to make up a hamper.**

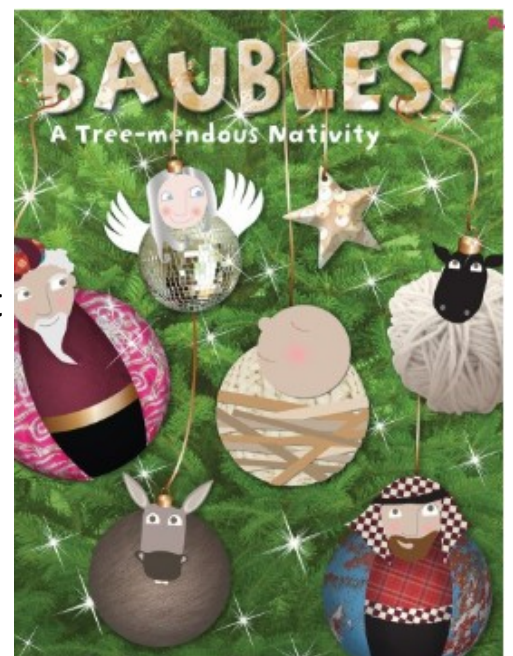
There is no charge for the non-uniform days; but we do ask that you send in a donation please for the Christmas Bingo, in exchange for your child coming to school in their own clothes.
