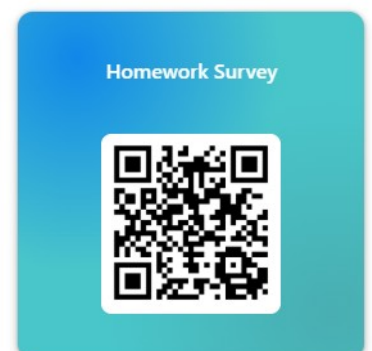
Thank you, as always, for the care you take in getting children into school and ready to learn. It truly does make a difference — one day at a time.
